

# Certificate Program Indian History

## Course Overview:

Creating a syllabus for a 3-month online certificate course on Indian History as per the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 will require aligning with its emphasis on a multidisciplinary, flexible, and holistic approach to education. The course should ideally cover the major periods of Indian history, reflect on various social, cultural, and political developments, and emphasize critical thinking, heritage, and a broad understanding of India's historical evolution.

## Duration:

12 Weeks (3 Months)

- 10th or 12th Pass
